Our words give voice to the gospel, while our actions give it substance and credibility. People are often more convinced by what they see lived out consistently than by mere rhetoric.

"Preach the gospel at all times and when necessary, use words" captures the comprehensive nature of sharing the message of Jesus. It calls us to be authentic ambassadors of Christ, embodying His teachings in both word and deed, and allowing His transformative power to work through us to impact the world around us.
