### **People of Hope**

In today's gospel we encounter a passage that speaks of cosmic upheaval and the end times, which can easily evoke fear and uncertainty. The imagery of the sun darkening, stars falling, and the heavens shaking seems overwhelming, even terrifying. Yet, Jesus' message is not meant to inspire fear, but to awaken us to a deeper truth—one of hope and trust in God's ultimate plan.

Today, as in Mark's time, many people approach the future with fear and apprehension. We face global challenges, personal struggles, and societal shifts that often make us anxious about what is to come. The unknown can seem daunting, and change can make us feel vulnerable. But as Christians, we are called to respond differently. Our faith invites us to look beyond the immediate chaos and turmoil and to see the signs of God's presence and promise even in the midst of uncertainty.

This passage reminds us that, despite the turmoil and trials, God remains sovereign. Christ's return is a promise of renewal and restoration, not destruction. We are not left to face an uncertain future alone, but are held by a loving God who has a dream for us. This is the foundation of Christian hope: the unwavering belief that God is good, that God loves us unconditionally, and that God's purposes for us are ultimately for our good.

The fig tree in the passage becomes a symbol of this hope. Just as the budding of the tree signals the nearness of summer, so too there are signs of God's presence and action in our lives if we have the eyes to see them. Our call is to live attentively and with trust, recognizing that even in times of upheaval, God is at work, bringing about new life.

We are invited to be people of optimism and confidence, knowing that the God who holds the universe in His hands also holds us.


# Stewardship
