A World transformed by Love

In today's gospel Jesus challenges us to expand our understanding of love, generosity, and mercy. Rather than reinforcing a transactional faith where good is rewarded, and evil is punished, Jesus presents a vision of God as unbounded compassion, inviting us into that same radical way of being.

At the heart of this passage is the Golden Rule: "Treat others as you would like them to treat you." This principle, found across many religious traditions, sounds simple, yet Jesus pushes it further. It is easy to love those who love us, but the true test is how we respond to those who oppose us, mistreat us, or seem undeserving of kindness.

Jesus speaks these words to people living under Roman occupation, calling them to love even their enemies. This is not a call to passivity but to a deeper transformation-one that refuses to mirror the cycles of hatred and retaliation. To love an enemy, to give without expecting return, to bless those who curse us-these actions are not just moral ideals but reflections of God's own nature.

The call to be compassionate as your Father is compassionate is not about achieving perfection but about living with a heart open to grace. God does not measure love in limited terms; rather, divine love is extravagant, poured out even on the undeserving. We are invited to reflect this generosity in our own relationships.

This passage reminds us that discipleship is not just about believing in Jesus but embodying his way of life. It is a movement away from keeping score and toward a freedom that comes from living in God's abundant mercy. This is not an easy path, but it is the way of the Kingdom-a world transformed by love.

Heart Speaks to Heart

Saint Bonaventure tells us that in the end we should not pray for light, but for "raging fire". He teaches that, "faith is in the intellect, in such a way as to provoke affection. In this sense, for example, the knowledge that Christ died for us does not remain knowledge, but necessarily becomes affection, love". Along the same lines, Saint John Henry Newman took as his motto the phrase Cor ad cor loguitur (heart speaks to heart), since, beyond all our thoughts and ideas, the Lord saves us by speaking to our hearts from his Sacred Heart. This realization led him, the distinguished intellectual, to recognize that his deepest encounter with himself and with the Lord came not from his reading or reflection, but from his prayerful dialogue, heart to heart, with Christ, alive and present. It was in the Eucharist that Newman encountered the living heart of Jesus, capable of setting us free, giving meaning to each moment of our lives, and bestowing true peace.


