Awakening to Glory

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

16 March 2025

At crucial moments in Jesus' life-when his identity and mission are being revealed-the disciples are often found asleep or struggling to stay awake. In Luke's account of the Transfiguration, he uniquely notes that Peter, James, and John were "weighed down with sleep" but managed to stay awake to see Jesus in his glory. It is a stark contrast to the Garden of Gethsemane, where their drowsiness overcomes them, leaving Jesus to face his agony alone.

This pattern of sleepiness points to more than just physical fatigue. It reflects a spiritual sluggishness-a resistance to fully grasping who Jesus is and what discipleship entails. The disciples struggle to comprehend the weight of Jesus' mission, and rather than being energized by his presence, they are often wearied by the demands of following him.

How often do we find ourselves spiritually asleep at crucial moments? We may long for an experience of God's presence, yet when the moment comes, we are distracted, preoccupied, or unprepared. The challenge of the Transfiguration is to remain awake-to be attentive to the ways Christ is revealing himself to us, even in unexpected ways.

Peter's response, though misguided, is sincere: he wants to build tents, to prolong the moment, to capture the divine radiance. But the voice from the cloud redirects him and the others: "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!" Rather than grasping at the glory of the moment, they are called to deep listening. And after the vision fades, they see "Jesus alone." The Transfiguration is not an escape from reality but a preparation for it-an invitation to see Jesus clearly, not only in his glory but in the suffering that is to come.

As we journey in faith, we are called to stay awake—to resist spiritual drowsiness and be present to the transforming power of Christ. Like the disciples, we may not always understand, and we may feel burdened by what is asked of us. But if we listen to him, we will find the grace to walk with him, not just on the mountaintop but also in the valleys of our lives.
